Essential SOPs for Final Exam

Here are the essential SOPs that will be valid from 15th October 2021 onwards until further notice.

Coming to College for Final Exam

- Only vaccinated individuals may enter College.
- Ensure your MySejahtera shows your vaccinated status; note that you will not be allowed to enter campus if your MySejahtera indicates your status as, Close Contact. Do a covid-19 **PCR test** to see if your positive.
- **DO NOT COME** to College if you are feeling unwell with all the covid-19 symptoms, or if a member of your household is tested positive. You need to show proof of your **PCR Test** to see whether you are positive/ negative.
- Covid-19 self-test kit or RTK Antigen test results will **NOT** be accepted if you unable to come to College for your final exam.

While in classroom for final exam

- Masks should be worn at all times.
 - Always maintain physical distancing of at least 1metre.
 - Avoid any physical contact.
 - Observe good personal hygiene.
 - Avoid sharing items such as stationery and utensils.
 - Do not move chairs or furniture, and only sit in designated areas.
 - Do not gather in groups along the corridors.
 - If you feel unwell while on-campus, please contact your lecturer or ATIC admin who will assist you.

If you are tested positive for COVID-19 before the final exam

- Immediately self-isolate immediately
- **Inform your Head of School on your condition.**
- Contact the nearest clinic to reconfirm your condition to confirm if you are positive.
- Strictly follow any advice you receive from the Kementerian Kesihatan Malaysia (KKM) and comply with their contact tracing procedures. Your MySejahtera will be updated.
- The College will contact you in order to conduct its own contact tracing for the health and safety of the College.
- Return to campus only when you have received clearance from the KKM.

If you have been identified as a close contact or suspect yourself to be a close contact before the final exam

- Immediately self-isolate yourself for a period of 5 days (from the point of last known contact if the identity of the individual tested positive is known).
- Do a covid-19 PCR test if you are showing symptoms of Covid 19 to see whether you are positive or not.
- **Immediately inform your Head of School on your condition.**
- The College will contact you in order to conduct its own contact tracing for the health and safety of College.
- Return to campus only after 7 days if you do not display any symptoms, unless you have been instructed otherwise by the KKM.
- If you are showing no Covid-19 symptoms and the RTK Antigen Test is negative, you are free from quarantine after 5 days.
